Full day in class or at home: Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday online
Connected Classes

THERE ARE NO CLASSES ON FRIDAY FOR ANY KINDERGARTEN – GRADE 12 STUDENTS; HOMEWORK PKGS WILL BE PICKED UP & DELIVERED ON FRIDAY'S BY OUR SCHOOL BUS.

On Friday our staff will contact parents with work that your child is to do at home. Those parents who want their child to study at home shall be provided work on a weekly basis each Friday. Principal shall notify all parents if the school is to shut down as situations warrant.

Until then our school shall operate with remaining students who are in attendance and work will be sent home by bus, each Friday, to those students that parents want to keep at home.

Teachers are preparing bags with school work for students who are at home (as well as for students who may later be at home).

Parent are asked to phone the school and talk with our Administration if they wish to leave messages for the teacher and principal:

Ask for Sondra OR Shannelle if you want to keep your child at home effective this week to December 18th -January 4th, 2021 (Winter Break).

Ask for Duane if a student needs computer or tech related help to get emails or assignments online between now and December 18th.
